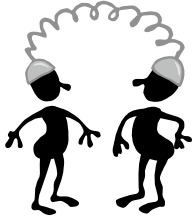


Advanced Peer Coaching

Strategies and Skills for Experienced Peer Coaches



No matter how long you have been a Peer Coach or have been in a position to give feedback to a colleague, it is often challenging to do this in a positive, supportive, professional, and non-judgmental manner. This workshop provides experienced educators with the second phase of advanced skills and strategies for coaching beginning teachers. Concepts and strategies practiced within this course include: Building Trusting Relationships; using an ongoing Formative Assessment process built around the California Standards for Teaching Profession (CSTP); using Observational Scripting Techniques; guiding Reflective Conversations, building awareness of non-verbal communication; distinguishing between evidence and opinion.

This activity meets HOUSSE criteria for standards-aligned professional development and is worth 1 unit of University Extended Education with prior attendance at Peer Coaching.
