ASSIGNMENT: Due Date

Over the course of four weeks you will need to take pictures in the following categories:

- Portraits** – people
- Nature Shots** – outdoors, scenery
- Animal Shots** – pets and wildlife
- Stop-action Shots** – sports, movement
- Three-part Sequences** – telling a story
- Trick Shots** – is it or isn't it?
- Pattern Shots** – close-ups

After you have taken your pictures (5 or more in each category), and have selected one in each category, you will need to create a different style of poem for each photograph. A sample of different poem types can be found at:
